Top 5 Tips for Top Notch PowerPoints

Give your PowerPoint Presentations a Face Lift!

Tip #1: Size Up!

A simple solution to maximize your slide "real estate" and to instantly modernize your PowerPoint is to use the "widescreen" slide size option as opposed to the "Standard 4:3" size option. This setting is located under the "Design $Tab" \rightarrow$ "Slide Size" \rightarrow "Widescreen" option.



Tip #2: Use a Template!

Use the COM PowerPoint Template. It provides consistency in branding and follows PowerPoint best practices. It is located here: https://goo.gl/JxRbzN






Tip #3: Be Consistent!

Avoid creating or moving text boxes. Use the "Layout Templates" available to you. This allows for the text boxes to be consistently placed and the fonts to be consistent colors/sizes. Layout templates are located under the "Home" tab

"New Slide" or "Home" tab
"Layout."



Tip #4: Manage Cognitive Load

• Be Consistent

 Keep the same slide format, colors, and fonts throughout your presentation.

Be Concise

 No more than 10 words per bullet point. No more than 7 lines per slide.

Be Conservative

No more than 2 images per slide.
 When paired with content text,
 images should not take up more than
 1/3 of the slide. Keep animations at a minimum.


