### Adobe Express and Acrobat Pro



Adobe Express is now available to all enrolled students and active employees. Acrobat Pro is available to employees. Follow the instructions below to sign-in and access.

Note: You can install Adobe Express or Acrobat Pro on up to two computers and remain signed in on both, but you can only actively use the app on one computer at a time.


\*\*FAU managed devices will have Acrobat Pro automatically installed or available in the Company Portal so will be able to open and sign in through the app. If you already have Acrobat Pro installed, sign out completely, and then sign back in and select the correct FAU-OIT VIP.

1. Visit [Account.adobe.com](#) and enter your FAU email address, click Continue




2. Select Company or School Account, the page will then route to the FAU Single Sign On login. Proceed to enter your FAU credentials, and Duo authentication.
3. Select FAU-OIT as the profile. This is important as this is the VIP that has the assigned licenses. If you select another VIP, one that you may have accessed previously, you will not have the FAU provided Adobe Express and Acrobat Pro licenses.
4. To access or download the applications to your computer, Select All Apps from

the Web Apps menu in the top right. This will show you all the apps you have access to.
