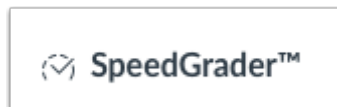

### How to Grade Canvas Assignments using a Rubric

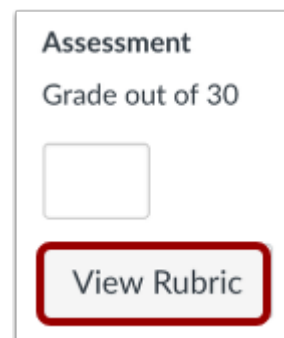
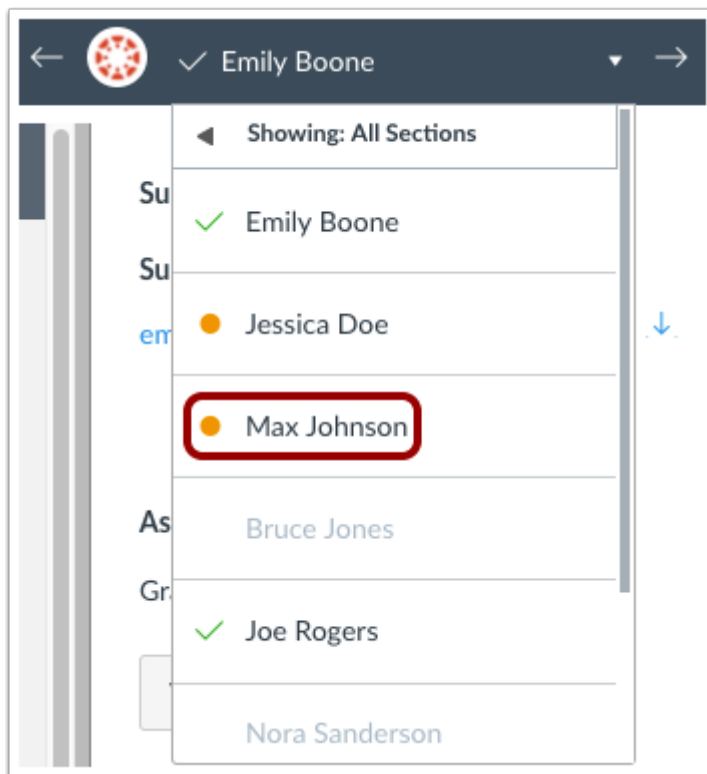
1. Log into [Canvas.fau.edu](https://Canvas.fau.edu) (web version)
2. Select the course

3. Navigate to **Assignments**
4. Select the desired assignment



5. Open **Speedgrader**
6. Locate student submissions by clicking the dropdown



7. Once you have selected the student submission, click **View Rubric**
8. To resize the rubric window, click and drag the sizing column horizontally. You may need to scroll horizontally and vertically to view the entire rubric.
