

Connect to the FAU Wireless Network

Register your Device

- 1. Connect to the fau wireless network from your wireless device (e.g., laptop or mobile device).
- The first time you open up a browser you will be redirected to the FAUNet ID Central Authentication Service.
- 3. Enter your FAUNet ID and password then click LOGIN.



- Enter a name for your device (ex: Joe's laptop). The MAC address should automatically appear in the box.
- 5. \boldsymbol{Accept} the Use Policy and then click $\boldsymbol{Register\ Device}.$

- 6. Authentication Successful! ** Very Important** Please wait a couple of minutes for settings to take effect or restart your computing device.
- 7. After your device has received its new network setting you should be able to browse the Internet without being prompted to log in.

- 1. Left Click on the icon that represents your wireless network
- 2. Select eduroam and click "Connect".
- After clicking on the "Connect", you will need to enter your FAUNet Id and password.
- 4. You are now connected to eduroam and you may begin to browse.

Mac OS Instructions

- 1. Click on the Wireless icon in the menu bar, and select "eduroam."
- 2. Enter you **FAUNet ID** and **password** in the credential window.
- 3. Click Join
- 4. You are now connected to EDUROAM.
