# Export/Import Outlook Folder

<u>How to export 1 or more Outlook email folders to a PST file.</u> Once exported it can be saved for archive or shared with another colleague who you would like to have access to all those emails.

IMPORTANT: Do not share your Outlook export with anyone outside of FAU/COM without approval.

Export:

- 1. Open Outlook and click on File and then Open & Export in the top left corner.
- 2. Click on Import/Export



3. Select Export to a file and click Next.
