Running an iClicker Cloud Polling Session


Once you have 1) opened the iClicker application, 2) logged in, 3) selected your course, and 4) started a polling session, follow the steps below.

Step 1: Pull up the question.

Step 2: Select "Polling."

Step 3: Select the question type and press play.

Step 4: Press the stop button when finished.

Step 5: Select "Results" on the iClicker Cloud menu.


