



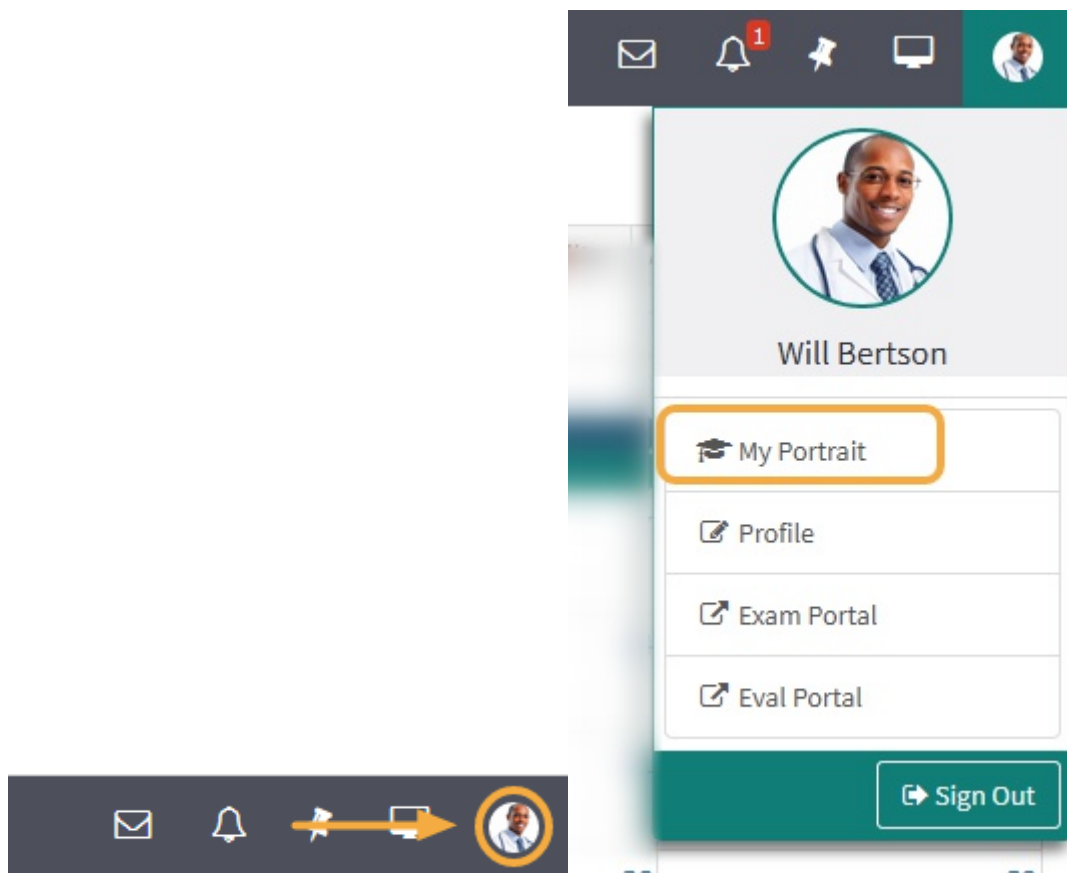

How to Access Your Academic Portrait

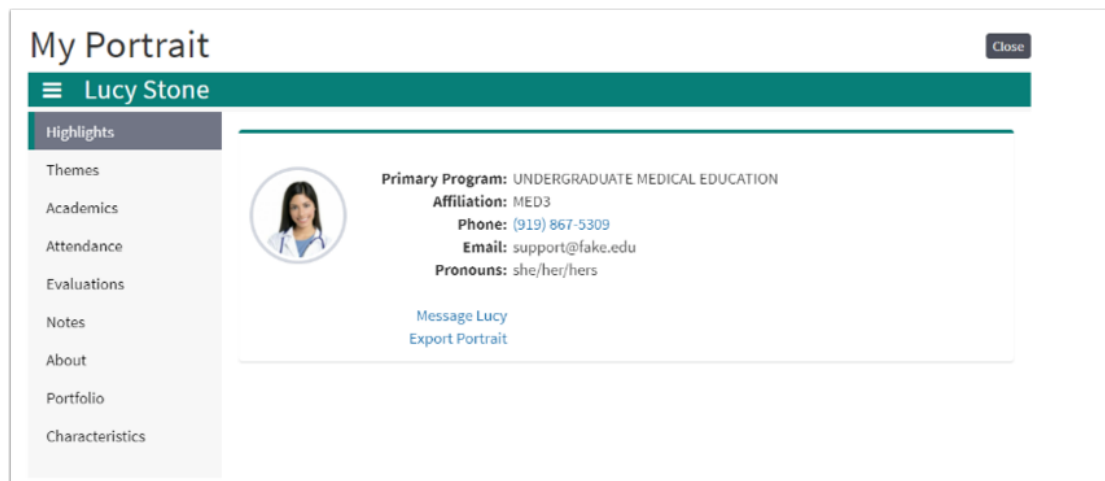
A Student can click on their picture to access **My Portrait**.



The Academic Portrait displays a Student's entire academic history in a simple comprehensive profile.

Academic Portrait Menu

Only the individual(s) explicitly assigned as the Student's mentor can view the Academic Portrait and related documentation, including the Portfolio.



A student's Academic Portrait is divided up into the following sections:

1. **Themes:** Displays performance data based on Theme-Mapped Evaluation Questions, Events, Procedures and Diagnoses over time.
2. **Academics:** A list of Courses the student has taken. Course specific grades can be displayed, if the institution chooses.
3. **Attendance:** This displays information about a Student's excused and unexcused absences.
4. **Evals (Evaluations):** Active evaluations and completed evaluations on or by the Student are listed here.
5. **Notes:** This lists all the notes that have been added to a Student's portrait.
6. **About:** General information and demographics about the Student are displayed on this page.
7. **Portfolio:** A category-based digital folder where Students and their Mentors can upload documents that they need to keep over a period of time.
8. **Noteworthy Characteristics:** A flexible tool for Students and Advisors to collaborate on authoring statements for the MSPE.
9. **Export Portrait:** Download documents in a .ZIP file.
