Connect to AirMedia in COM 126 and 128

- 1. Select the "Wireless" display option on the Crestron panel
- $2. \ \ Connect \ to \ the \ EDUROAM \ wireless \ network$
- If using an iOS or Android device- download the AirMedia app/software if you haven't already

- 4. When prompted, enter the classroom-specific web address which is displayed in the top-left corner of the projected screen and press CONNECT.
- 5. Depending on the version of Airmedia, you may be guided through AirPlay Connection with an onscreen window. If you see this, follow the instructions.
