Apple Pencil (1st generation)



How to pair the first-generation Apple Pencil

- 1. Make sure the iPad you want to use is **on and unlocked**, then **uncap** your Pencil.
- 2. Plug in your Pencil to the iPad you want to Pair the Pencil with.
- 3. When the Bluetooth Pairing Request appears, tap Pair.
- 4. You are all set.

How to check your Apple Pencil (first generation) battery level

- Swipe down from the iPad's top bezel to invoke Notification Center (or turn the iPad on to view the Lock screen).
- 2. Swipe right to see the Widgets screen.
- 3. View the **Batteries** section.

How to charge the first-generation Apple Pencil using the iPad

- 1. Remove the cap from your Apple Pencil
 - 1. (During the charging process, you can magnetically attach the cap to the iPad next to the Home button).
- 2. Insert your Apple Pencil's Lightning connector into your iPad or iPad Pro's Lightning port.



How to charge the first-generation Apple Pencil using the Lightning adapter

- 1. Remove the ${f cap}$ from the back of your ${\bf Apple\ Pencil}.$
- 2. Insert your Apple Pencil's **Lightning connector** into the **Lightning adapter**.
- 3. Plug the **Lightning adapter** into your **Lightning cable**.
