### Running an iClicker Cloud Polling Session

Once you have 1) opened the iClicker application, 2) logged in, 3) selected your course, and 4) started a polling session, follow the steps below.

**Step 1:** Pull up the question.

**Step 2:** Select "Polling."

**Step 3:** Select the question type and press play.

**Step 4:** Press the stop button when finished.
