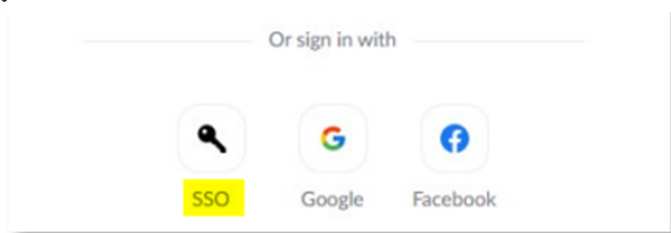

SIGN IN TO FAU-LICENSED ZOOM ACCOUNT

This how-to guide explains 3 ways to sign in to your FAU Zoom account.

Option 1: ZOOM DESKTOP APPLICATION

- 1. Download the Zoom Application (Personal Machine: <https://zoom.us/download>, COM-Issued Machine: [click here](#))
- 2. Download and install the Zoom Client for Meetings.
- 3. Once installed, open the Zoom app on your computer.
- 4. Click the Sign In button.
- 5. Click the Sign in with SSO button.
- 6. Enter fau-edu as the company domain and click the Continue button.


- 7. A browser window will open and may require you to sign in. If prompted, sign in with your FAUNet ID credentials.
- 8. The browser will then redirect you to the Zoom application.

Option 2: FAU WEB PORTAL

- 1. Open a web browser and go to <https://fau-edu.zoom.us>
- 2. Click the button and enter your FAU credentials if prompted.
 - a. First time users: Confirm your email address if prompted. Follow the prompts to continue setting up your account.
 - b. **Users with PERSONAL Zoom accounts:**
 - i. You will be asked to switch/merge accounts. Follow the prompts to continue merging your accounts.
- 3. Your Zoom account should now be completely associated with FAU's license.

Option 3: GENERAL ZOOM LOGIN

- 1. Open a web browser and go to <https://zoom.us>
- 2. Click the button on the top right corner.
- 3. Click the (SSO) button.
- 4. Enter **fau-edu** as the company domain and click the Continue button.
- 5. Enter your FAUNet ID credentials.
- 6. You should now be signed in to Zoom.
